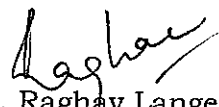

ORDER

Subject: First Appeal filed by Dr. S.S. Tantia Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Sriganganagar, Rajasthan, for Consideration of Application for starting PG course in MS-Obstetrics & Gynecology for AY 2025-26.

The Medical College has filed the present appeal seeking consideration of its application for starting postgraduate course in MS-Obstetrics & Gynecology with five (05) seats for the Academic Year (AY) 2025–26, stating that on the scheduled date of submission, i.e., 10.12.2024, the online application could not be completed due to expiry of the portal session at the payment stage despite all requisite details having been duly filled. The College has further submitted that the issue was immediately reported to the concerned authorities, but remained unresolved despite follow-up.

2. The present appeal is being considered in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jodhpur, vide order dated 08.01.2026 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 212/2026, directing the Appellate Authority of the National Medical Commission to decide the pending appeal dated 24.12.2025 (Annexure-9) filed by the petitioner-College by passing a speaking order, strictly in accordance with law, within the stipulated time frame.

3. In compliance of the aforesaid directions of the Hon'ble High Court, the present First Appeal has been admitted, and the Appeal Committee, constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr. Abhijat Chandrakant Sheth, Chairman, NMC and two Members, met on 16.01.2026 to consider the said Appeals filed by the Medical College. The following Appeal Committee members were present during the meeting:
